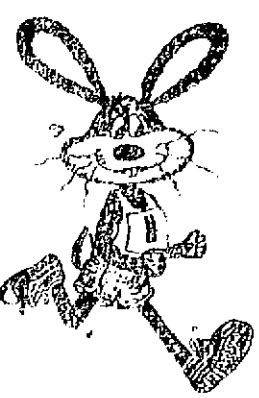

 signed to help abused and neglected  
 senior citizens has passed Senate  
 unanimously.  
 The legislation, which was sent to  
 the House Tuesday, would require  
 health care professionals and social  
 services workers to report any cases  
 in which they believe an elderly per-  
 son is being abused, neglected, ex-  
 ploited or abandoned.
